

REWARD OFFER HIGHLIGHTS ARSON AWARENESS WEEK

Buffalo Fire Department officials kicked off Arson Awareness Week today with **Enviro-Care** Inc. representatives who announced a reward of up to \$2,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of persons committing arson in the city.

Enviro-Care, an emergency restoration company responding to fire and water damage, is providing posters promoting the reward. The posters, fire officials said, will be placed on burned buildings. Arsons in the city has increased from 268 in 1993 to 327 in 1995, costing the city \$5 million, the officials said.
